Parade Day Information - Registration begins at 8:30 am

- 1. <u>Registration</u> will be located at the intersection of Loop 230 & Fawcet St. in the Fire Station. All participants must be registered no later than 10 am for judging. The parade will start promptly at 2:00 PM, rain or shine.
- 2. <u>Route:</u> Parade line-up will begin on 1st. St. There will be numbers painted on the street that will match with your parade entry number provided to you at check-in. The parade will begin at Loop 230 & Whitehead St. Travel down Loop 230 to Olive St, turn left then right onto First St., right onto Main St. and conclude at the intersection of Main & N.W. 5th. St. turning right onto 5th. St. ending the parade. Changes in the parade line-up the day of parade will be at the sole discretion of the Jamboree Parade Officials.
- **4.** Awards will be presented by the judges before the parade starts:

Smithville Jamboree Parade Rules & Regulations

- 1. You must be in line and prepared for judging at the appropriate time.
- 2. Consumption of **alcoholic beverages** by drivers or any participants before or during the parade is **strictly forbidden**. If caught drinking, you will be escorted from the parade and this will jeopardize future parade participation.
- **3.** Autos & large vehicles must be driven by a licensed driver. Small vehicles (mini bikes, small tractors, go-carts, etc.) must be operated by a person age 12 or older with parents signed permission. All pets must be on leashes.
- **4.** Parade participants are not permitted to leave vehicles to demonstrate in any street or to stop or slow the forward movement of the parade in any way.
- 5. Throwing items such as candy during the parade is PROHIBITED. You may, however, have a person walking close to the curb handing out candy, Etc..
- **6.** When disbanding on N.W. 5th. Street, units shall not block the flow of traffic for participants following behind them.
- 7. All horse riders MUST KEEP CONTROL OF THEIR HORSE AT ALL TIMES. If a horse becomes unruly, you must leave the parade route.
- **8.** Exceptions to the rules may be made only with the approval of the Parade Officials. Return entry form to the following address:
